a) Residents raised the following issues:

Steven Gough, Planning Director from Firstway Solar attended the meeting to go through the proposal of the battery farm at Egginton. The presentation will be added to the website for information.

b) District Cllr. I. Hudson was absent from the meeting however sent the following report:

Bittern View Estate

The SDDC owned house now has carpets fitted and some furniture installed. It is nearing use, I accept that the process has taken far too long when SD is in need of such housing.

The developer has managed to delay injunction proceedings on road and pavement completion, I am assured by SDDC Legal that this is merely (another) delay, and matters are progressing.

You will all have noticed that Derbyshire SNT (police) attended an Anti-Social Behaviour incident on the Green Space at the rear of Bittern View Estate last month. They generated an incident number and taped off (with police tape) the unofficial access point to this area from Kingfisher Way. The tape is now removed and our PCSO is monitoring the area. I have passed this information onto SDDC and asked them to report to me on whether they can legally close access to this site. This is not the first ASB concern here.

Planning Matters

I see you have the Chesterfield - Willington 'The Great Grid Upgrade' on the agenda, I attended the first of a series of webinars on this. Every house in Willington should have received a consultation leaflet. The online resources listed in this leaflet are very good. The webinar less so. I passed on initial concerns that there is no Official Information point at all in South Derbyshire (the closest is Erewash) and that our closest consultation presentation is at Findern village hall (Findern is not directly affected).

However all consultations and webinars are now postponed until after the General Election.

This is a National Infrastructure project, so SDDC will not decide, HM Inspectorate will.

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The route for the new pylons is still to be finalised, however the line will come from Aston, so the East into Willington Power Station.

There is no significant works required on the Willington Power Station site.

I also see that the Egginton BESS will be presented to you. This is DMPA/2024/0432, although the Batteries are proposed to be installed in another Parish it would (if approved) have significant impact on Willington with cables underneath all of Castleway and a large portion of Twyford Road, circa 3kM in length. This will be decided at full Planning Committee, but probably not just yet as Derbyshire County Highways have asked for a delay, next SDDC Planning Committee is 18 June.

County Election Boundary, your item 19

There was a consultation on changing Derbyshire County Electoral Boundaries, this was meant to be finished, but due to a 'consultation error' with SDDC, the consultation has been extended. The idea is to try to balance out electors between divisions, there has been significant growth in some areas since the last review and so this suggestion.

For Willington it means splitting our SDDC Ward (Willington and Findern), Willington will go off into a new County Division with Stenson Fields and Repton, called 'Repton and Stenson'. Findern will remain with Etwall. I would prefer the new Division to be called 'Willington, Repton and Stenson'.

Finally, there is a General Election on July 4th, maybe you have all heard, well everyone has until 18th June to register to vote (19th to register for a postal vote).
