NOTIFICATION OF ESSENTIAL SAFETY MAINTENANCE WORKS A38 Toyota Junction to Kingsway Roundabout

I'm writing to let you know that we'll be carrying out essential safety maintenance works to the A38, between Toyota and Kingsway roundabouts. During this work, we will be carrying out visual surveys and replacing any defective parts to the Vehicle Restraint System.

When will the work take place?

Work is due to start on **8 April 2024** is scheduled for completion by the **beginning of August 2024**

Please note that all our planned roadworks may be subject to change due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances.

How will the work affect traffic?

To keep our programme for these works as short as possible and to minimise disruption to the local community, residents, businesses, and road users, we'll work between **8pm** and **6am Monday** to **Friday**.

To carry out the work safely in the central reservation we'll require a full carriageway closure and a lane closure on the opposite carriageway for safety. A 50mph speed limit will also be in place and all laybys in the works area will be closed.

During all road closures we'll put in place fully signed diversion routes which have been agreed with Local Authorities for this important safety improvement work. All carriageways will be open as usual outside our working hours.

All emergency vehicles will be granted access at all times.

How will the work affect businesses and residents?

We'll ensure that access to businesses and residences is maintained wherever possible.

We apologise for any inconvenience caused and will do our very best to complete the work as quickly as possible, keeping disturbances and noise to a minimum.
